## Dunstan Hospital, Clyde



Clyde is situated 199km north-west of Dunedin City (approximately 2 hours 45 mins drive). It is part of the Central Otago district.



Dunstan Hospital was rebuilt and opened in 2005 and is a busy, 24 bed facility that provides a broad range of secondary health services to around 25,000 people living in the Central Otago and Wanaka regions.

Dunstan Hospital provides acute inpatient care and has 24 beds, including a 3 bed High Dependency Unit. We provide acute medical care, rehabilitation and palliative care for people throughout the age spectrum. Other services include:

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### Clyde

Clyde is a township tucked in the rugged sub-alpine landscape of the region of Central Otago, amid a magnificent schist rock landscape not found in any other part of New Zealand. The historic gold mining town lies at the entry to the Cromwell Gorge and is just below the Clyde Hydro Electric dam and Lake Dunstan. The mighty Clutha river flows alongside. It is a short distance away from Alexandra, the commercial hub of Central Otago.

It is a region of great contrasts with the blossom and wild thyme flowers of spring, the searing heat and aridness of summer, the sublime and stunning autumn colours, and the bitter cold and hoar frosts of winter. The town is surrounded by an area renowned first for gold then for its stone fruit orchards - more recently huge areas of grapes have been planted with local vineyards producing their internationally renowned Pinot Noir.
